





## FOUNDATIONS FREEDOM NIGHT

We asked some Foundations members what their win was from Freedom Night:



**Blane from South Tampa:** One of the greatest freedoms I found in Foundations was laying my issues at the cross. I discovered that our surrender is all He needs to work miracles in our lives.

**Gloria from Clearwater:** Foundations provided such powerful teaching. The content challenged people to be serious about going to the next level and doing the harder things: obedience and walking out freedom. It was so good!

**Jessie from Brandon:** Foundations taught me to stop holding on to things I should have forgiven. Also, that if you live for Jesus, you can't live in the world's culture.

**Frank from St. Pete:** I learned that my freedom comes with a cost. The revelation of Jesus' sacrifice for me and my willingness to be fully committed changed everything.





Jimmy from South Tampa: The Holy Spirit reminded me of what I really needed to nail to the cross, not what I had originally thought, and now, "I am free." I personally prayed for two individuals that had been hanging onto anger, disappointment, and unforgiveness from parents that mistreated them. I believe they both were finally able to give it to Jesus and be released. One person said that was the first time they came forward and engaged with a person to pray over them.

**Georganna from South Tampa:** I really learned to move life forward in the direction God wants me to go and stop looking back.

Joey from St. Pete: It was life changing. Tearing up the piece of paper at the cross and releasing the guilt and burden of unforgiveness was so powerful. Praying for each other was very impactful as well!
